An Act amending title 3, chapter 25, subchapter VI, section 581 of the Virgin Islands Code relating to vacation payments for retiring teachers and other school personnel

PROPOSED BY: Senator Dwayne M. DeGraff

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands

SECTION 1. Title 3, chapter 25, subchapter VI, section 581, subsection (c) of the Virgin Islands Code is amended by inserting the following at the end:

“However, school teachers and other Department of Education employees whose services are performed primarily during the school year who work with the daily operation of the schools, who upon retirement have not received an annuity payment for more than 90 days, are entitled to an advance equal to 480 hours against their retirement annuity payable within 15 days of a written request.”

Bill Summary

This bill would allow teachers and school personnel to receive an advance against their retirement upon retirement from government service in the event that they are not paid an annuity for more than 90 days or more from the date of retirement.
