Introduction

This report represents statistical data complied by the Planning, Research and Development Staff of the Virgin Islands Police department. The data was drawn from information captured by our investigative units, reports archived by records management bureau and the Crime Analyst who collect additional information for Murder and Shooting incidents.

The crime data/charts contained in this report represent crimes occurring from Fiscal and Calendar years 2016 through 2018.

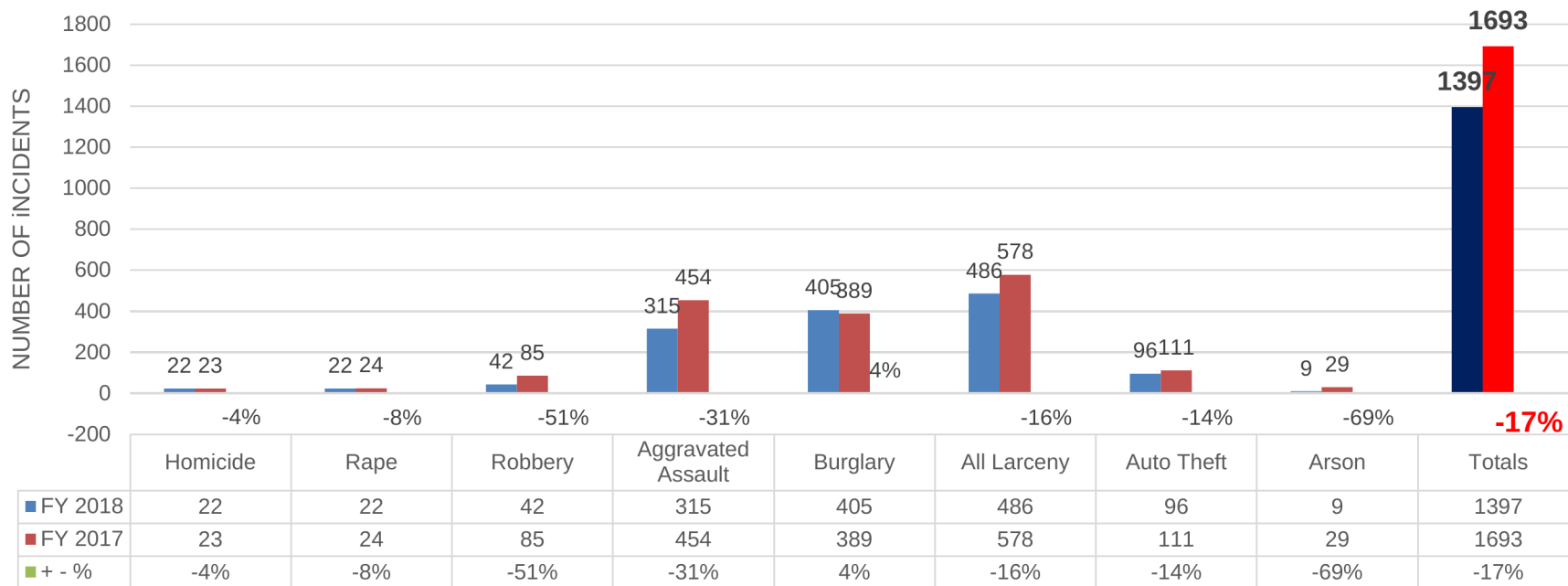


TERRITORIAL PART ONE CRIME STATISTICS

When comparing FY2018 vs FY2017 during the period of October through May, there has been a reduction in our Part One crimes in the territory by **17 %**, . (Table 1 & 2) and a **30%** reduction for CY 2018 vs CY 2017 for the period January through May, (Table 3)

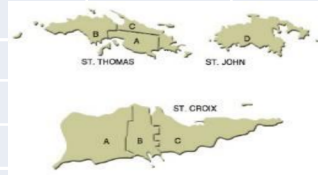

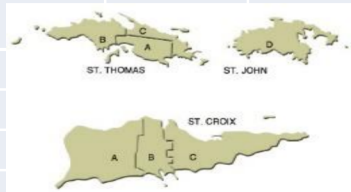

TERRITORIAL HOMICIDE STATISTICS

For the FY 2018, the period of October 2017 through June 2018, we have recorded **24** homicides territorially; **10** on St. Thomas, 0 on St. John and **14** on St. Croix. For the same period, last year, there were **31** homicides; **20** on St. Thomas, 0 on St. John and **11** on St. Croix. (Table 4 & 5)

COMPARING FY 2017- 2018 (to date June 30, 2018)

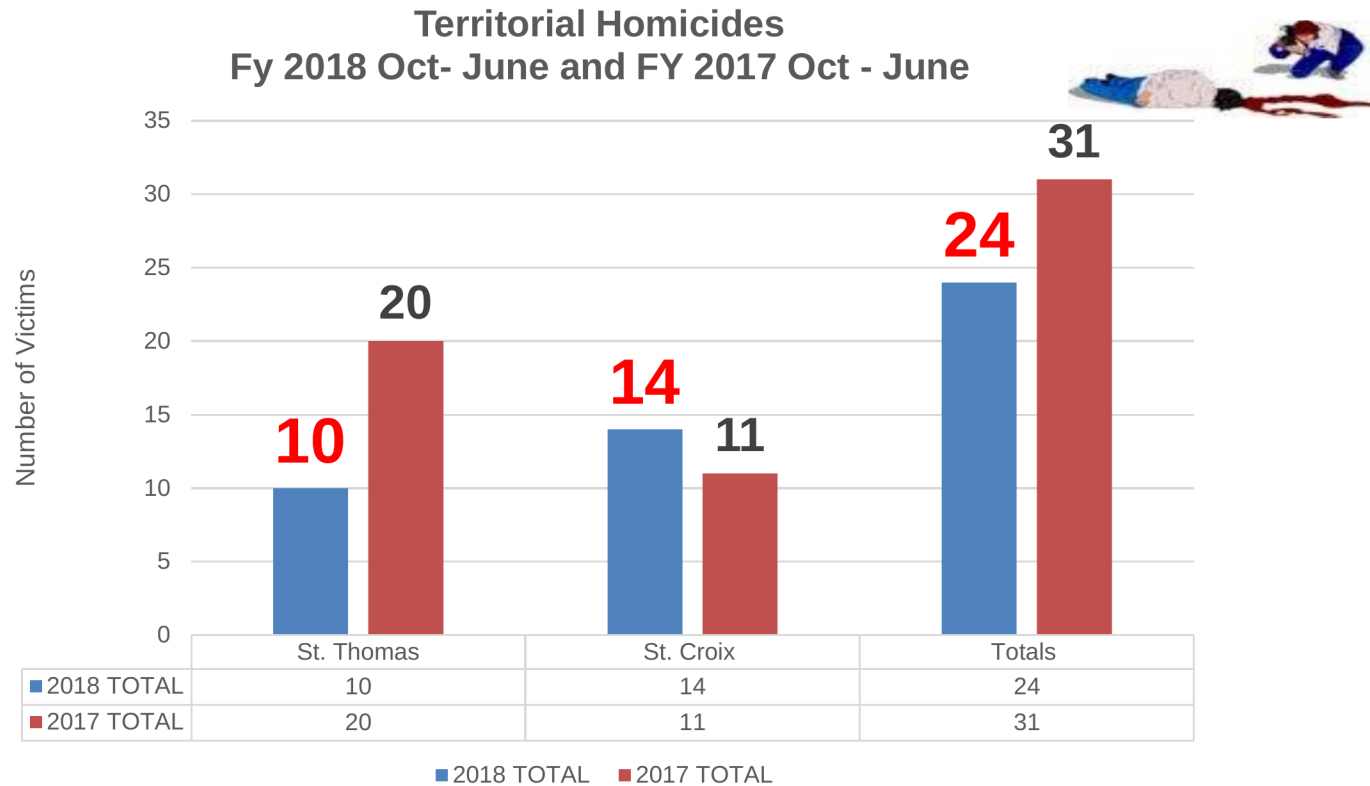

COMPARING 2017-2018 (to date June 30, 2018)

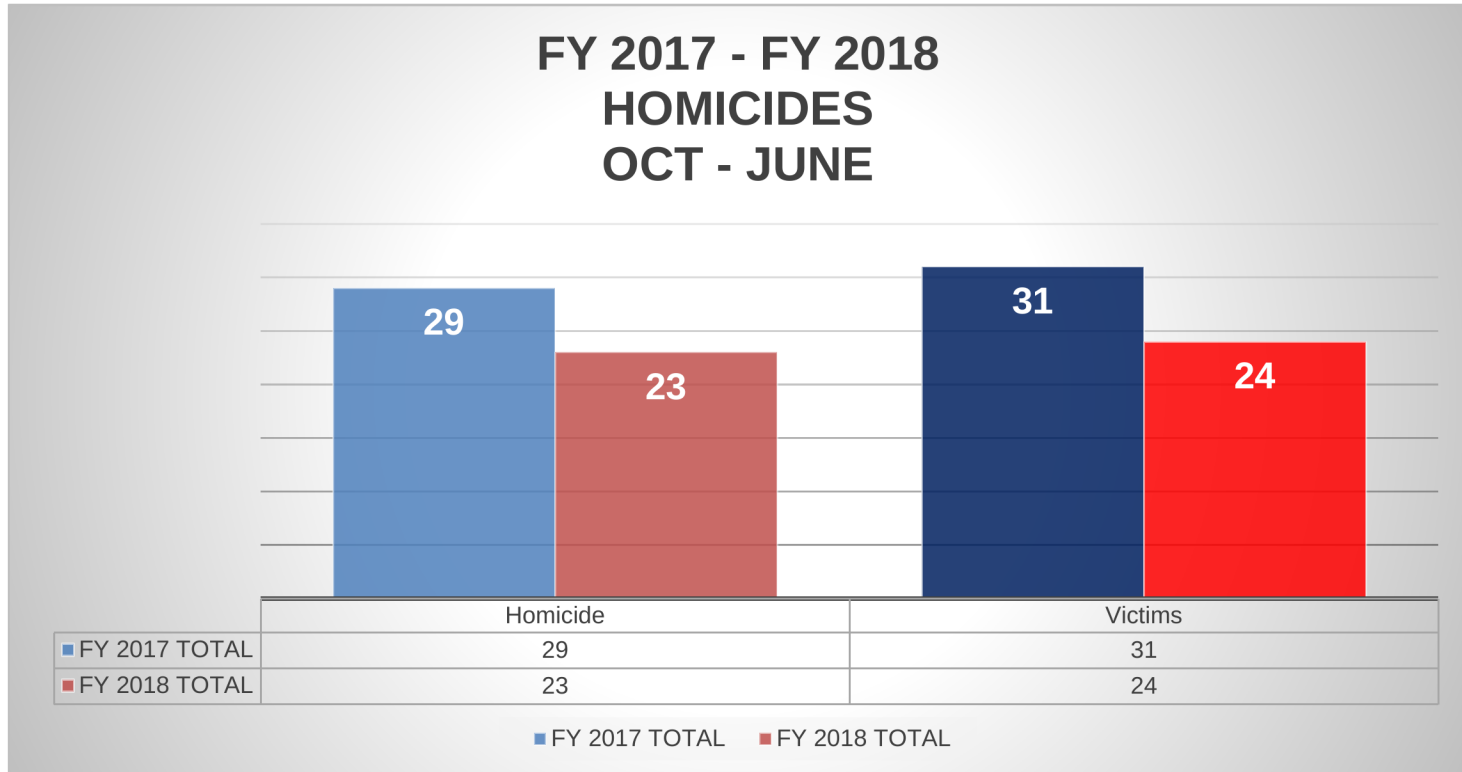

For the CY 2017 January through December we recorded **24** Homicides on St. Croix; **28** on St. Thomas, and **0** on St. John, for a territorial total of **52**.

COMPARING CY 2017 January – December 2017

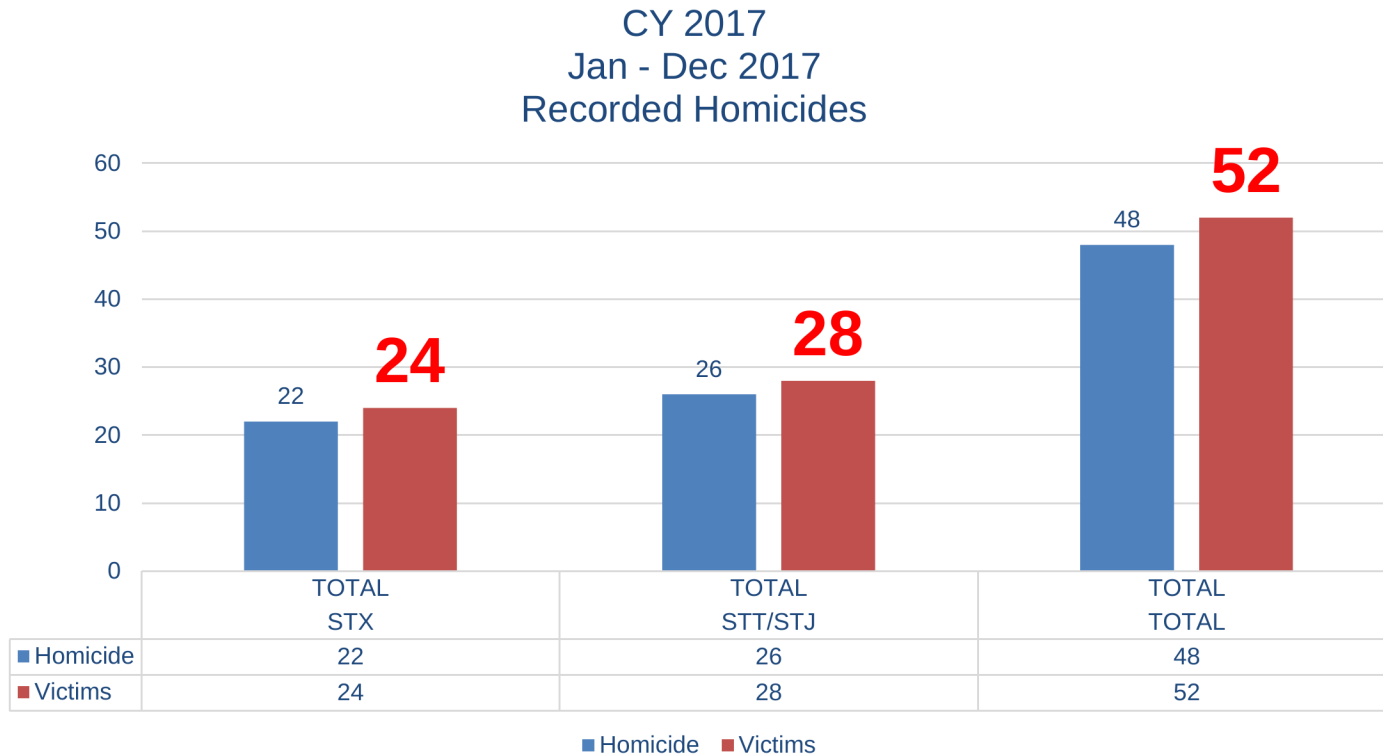

For the CY 2018 period January 2018 through June 2018, we have recorded **12** homicides on St. Croix **7** on St. Thomas, 0 on St. John, for a territorial total of **19. (Table 7).**

CY 2018 (January - June 2018)

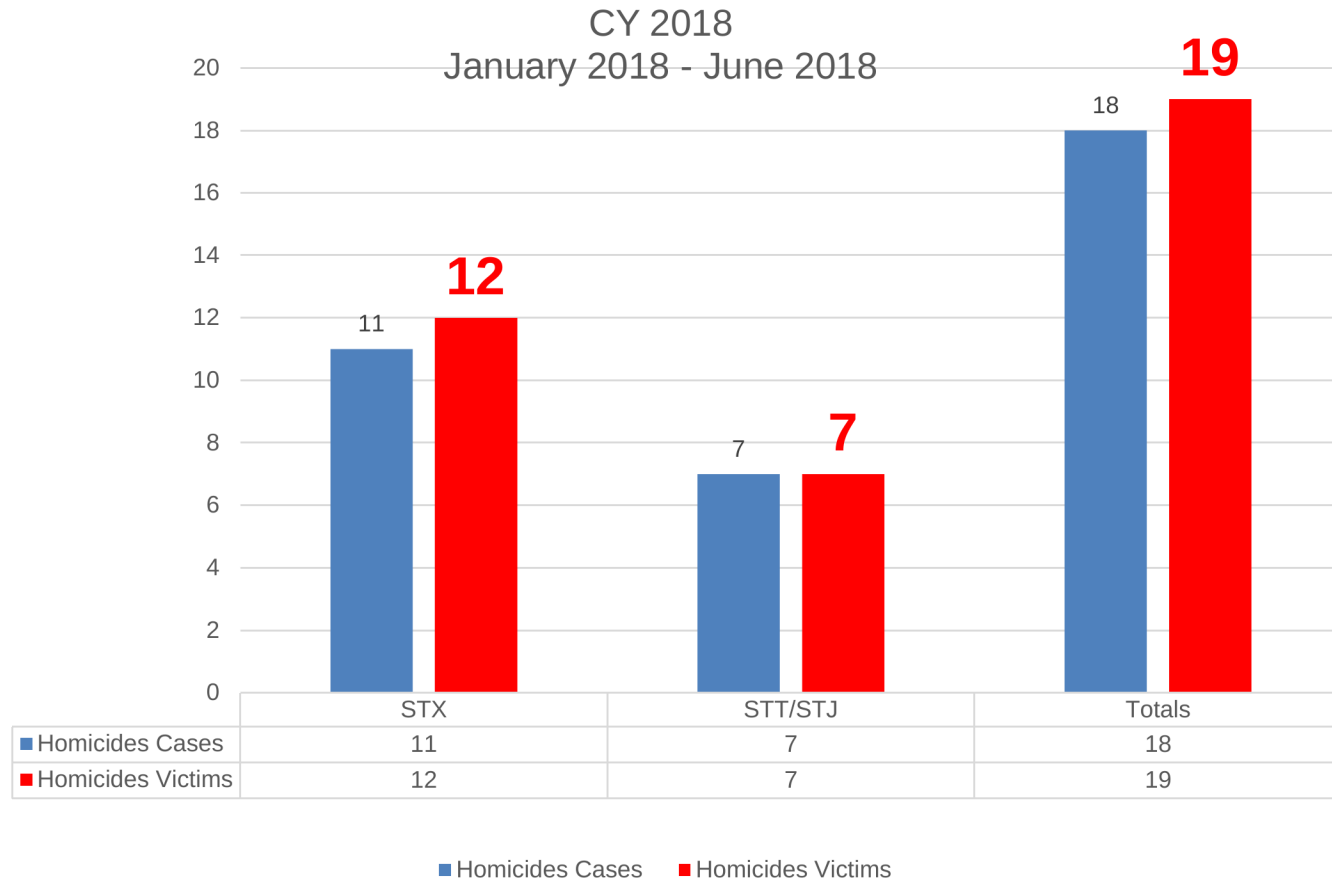

HOMICIDES ACCORDING TO CAUSE – OF – DEATH CLASSIFICATION TERRITORY WIDE

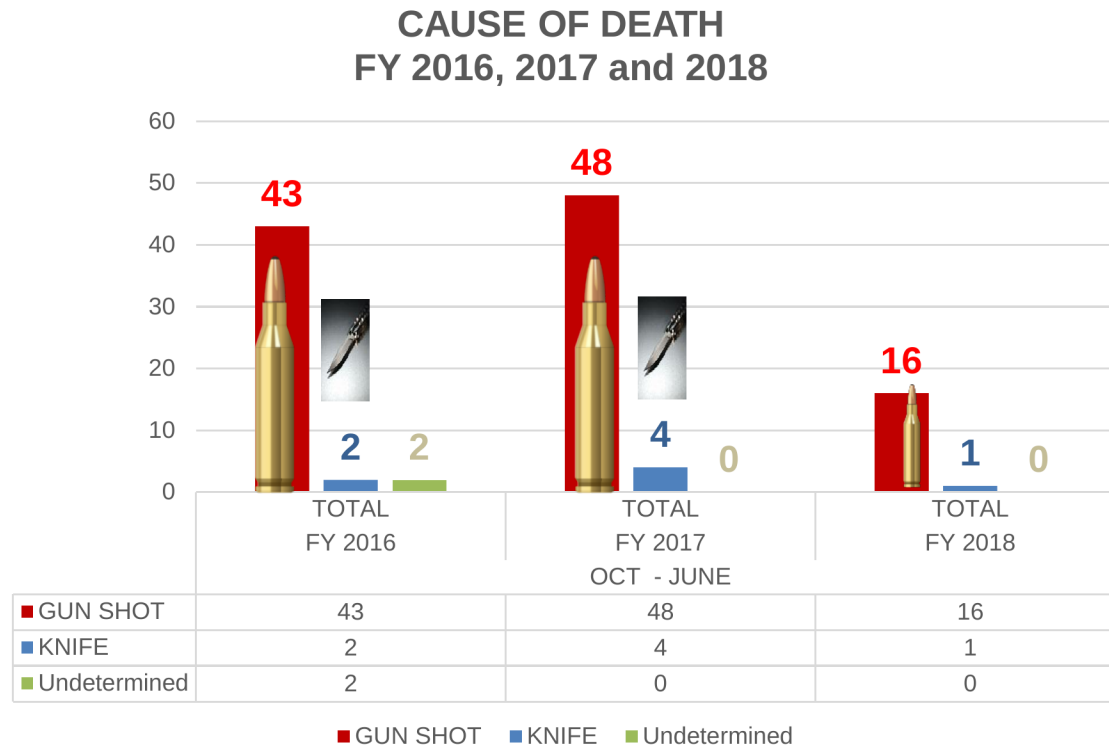

TERRITORIAL FIREARMS RECOVERY STATISTICS

For FY2017, during the full fiscal period of October 2016 through September 2017, we recovered **179** firearms territorially; **103** in the St. Croix District and **76** in the St. Thomas/St. John District.

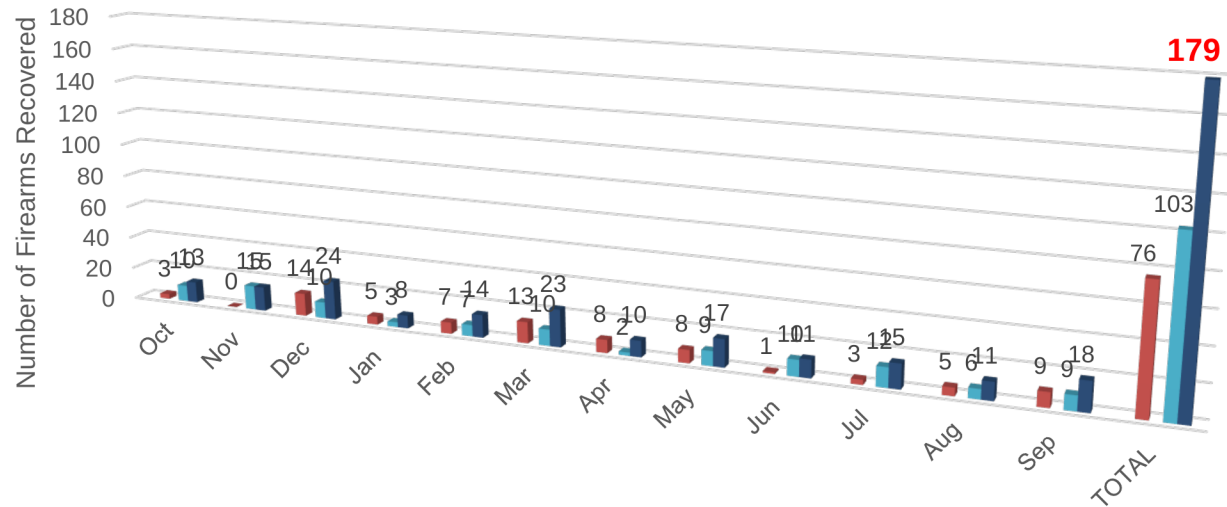

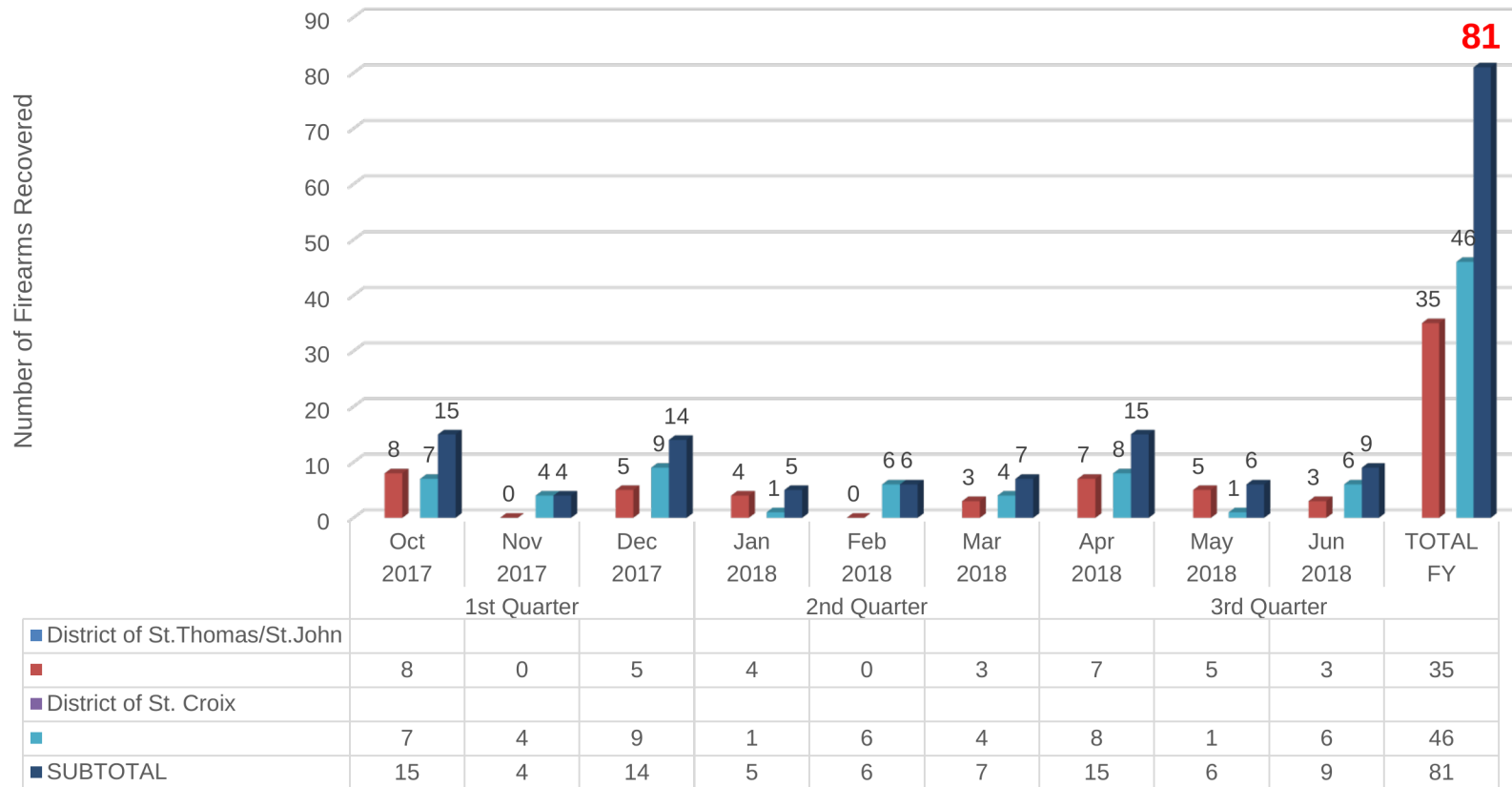
