Dear Supervisor Fawkes:

We are writing to you because the Democratic Party of the Virgin Islands has a responsibility to all residents of the Virgin Islands to ensure that every election is conducted in a legitimate manner with legitimate candidates in accordance with the laws of the Virgin Islands. Because of the questions being raised again about the validity of the candidacy of former Senator Alicia Hansen, and in order to preserve the integrity of the upcoming election, it is imperative that the Election System of the Virgin Islands assure the public that she has met all requirements and fulfilled all responsibilities to be legally qualified to be on the ballot for the November 8, 2016 General Election.

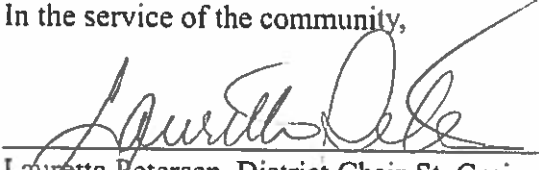
Pursuant to the Petition for Name Change filed by former Senator Alicia Hansen in the Superior Court of the Virgin Islands on July 12, 2016, it became evident that her legal name is Alden Alicia Pickering and not the Alicia Hansen. Consequently, the public is left to question whether Alicia Hansen is properly registered to vote in the Virgin Islands and, under the circumstances, whether she was properly certified as a candidate in the November 8, 2016 General Election. It is up to the Supervisor of Elections to determine whether Alicia Hansen does or does not meet the qualifications. Title 18, Section 411(b) of the Virgin Islands Code provides that "If the Supervisor determines that a candidate for election or nomination does not meet the qualifications established by law for the office, then he (she) shall disqualify such candidate and delete the candidate's name from the ballot if the ballots have not been printed".

Of course, in the alternative, if the candidate is found to be qualified, no action need be taken. But it is our position that the public would have been well served by the matter having been settled once and for all.

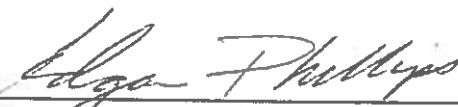

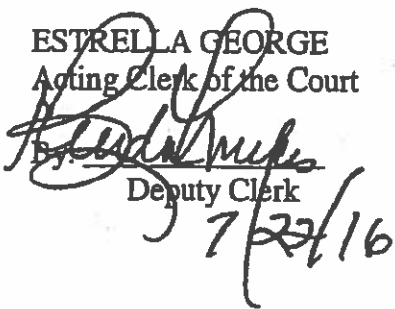

ORDER

THIS MATTER is before this Court on Petitioner Alden Alicia Pickering's, a.k.a Alicia Hansen's (Petitioner) *pro se* Petition for Name Change pursuant to 16 V.I.C. 181.

For resolution before this Court is Petitioner's request that the Court waive the public notice requirement set out in 16 V.I.C. 182.

FACTS

On July 12, 2016, Petitioner filed a petition requesting a change of name from Alden Alicia Pickering to Alicia "Chucky" Hansen.¹ Per Petitioner, the reason she is requesting the name change is to "[M]ake all...documents consistent with the name [she's] been known for all of [her] life, that is reflected on [her] United States Passport, and that the public is familiar with as a senator and politician for the last 25 years." Per Petitioner, the "Hansen" name stems from her 40-year-long marriage to Esdel E. Hansen.

RELEVANT LAW

Per 16 V.I.C. 182:

Before adjudging a change of name, except as provided in chapter 5 of this title, *the court shall require public notice of the application therefor to be given that all persons may appear and show cause, if they have any, why the same should not be granted.* The court shall also require public notice to be given of the change adjudged, and on return of proof thereof may grant a certificate, under the seal of the court, of the name the party is to have, and which shall thereafter be his legal name and a copy thereof shall be furnished the proper

¹ There are two petitions of record filed by this *pro se* petitioner – one on July 11, 2016 and the other on July 12, 2016. The July 11, 2016 petition requests a name change from Alicia Hansen to Alicia "Chucky" Hansen. The July 12, 2016 petition requests a name change from Alden Alicia Pickering to Alicia "Chucky" Hansen. In so far as the July 12, 2016 petition was filed later in time, this Court will deem said petition as superseding that filed on July 11, 2016.

local registrar of vital statistics. If the child has been baptized in the Virgin Islands the proper church officials shall also be notified of such change of name.²

DISCUSSION

At issue is whether this Court has the authority to waive the notice provision contained within 16 V.I.C. 182. It does not.

This narrow issue presents a matter of statutory construction. The first step when interpreting a statute is to determine whether the language at issue has a plain and unambiguous meaning. In re. Adoption of Sherman, 49 V.I. 452, 456 (V.I. 2008). If the statutory language is unambiguous and the statutory scheme is coherent and consistent, no further inquiry is needed. Shoy v. People, 55 V.I. 919, 926 (V.I. 2011).

This Court finds the statutory scheme to be coherent and consistent.³ Further, in Section 182 the Legislature uses the term “shall” in setting out the two instances in which notice is required under the statute – upon application and post adjudication. The Virgin Islands Legislature has instructed that “[w]ords and phrases” in the Virgin Islands code “shall be construed according to the common and approved usage of the English language” unless the word has “acquired a peculiar and appropriate meaning in the law. 1 V.I.C. 42. Applying this directive, the term “shall” means “[H]as a duty to . . . is required to.” Black’s Law Dictionary 1585 (10th ed. 2014).

CONCLUSION

The premises having been considered, this Court finds that it does not have the authority under the law to provide the petitioner with the relief she is seeking. Neither of the notice provisions are waivable.⁴

² Notice provisions italicized.

³ Title 16 V.I.C. 181, which provides for an application for change of name “except a woman upon her marriage or divorce,” does not impact this case to yield a contrary result. A strict reading of the provisions shows that it does not provide for a name change by operation of law, thus arguably obviating the need for judicial determination. However, a grammatical reading of the statute suggests that it merely states that for cases that fall within the enumerated categories (i.e. marriage, divorce, or adoption of a child) the Court need not address whether “sufficient reasons not inconsistent with the public interest” exists. As such, the notice provisions of 16 V.I.C. 182 would still apply.

However, even if it did, the facts of this case show that Petitioner used the name “Alicia Hansen” to apply for the marriage license – the implication being that the name “Hansen” was utilized even prior to the marriage. Further, the change being undertaken is a change to the first name and the last name (to wit, “Alden” and “Pickering”) rather than simply the surname, as is traditionally the case with marriage name changes.

⁴ Similarly, there is no common law support for waiver. It is important to distinguish the seminal case of In re. Bevans, 13 V.I. 251 (V.I. 1977). In Bevans, the Court held that where the subject of the name change is a five-month-old baby who was simply requesting that his middle name be changed, “publication in a newspaper would serve no useful purpose and public notice as required by 16 V.I.C. 182 can be satisfied by posting as is required by 15 V.I.C. 496.” Id.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the Petitioner's Motion to Waive Publication is **DENIED**;
2. That a copy of this Order be served on the Petitioner.

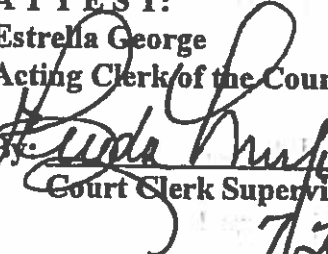

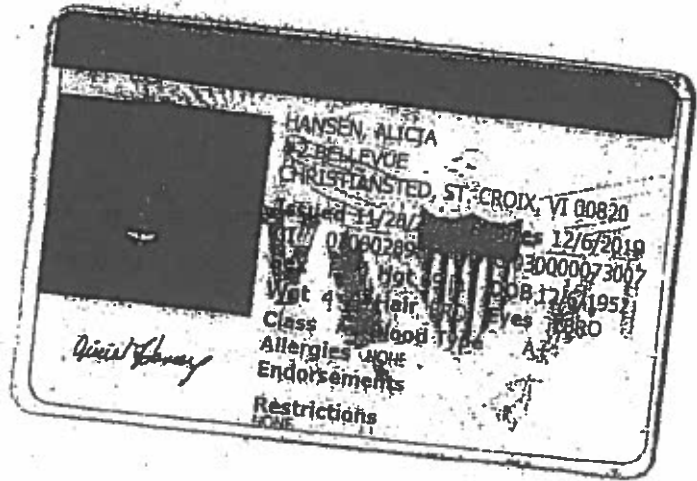

U.S. Olympic men's basketball team tops Nigeria in last tuneup

HOUSTON (AP) — There were no bumps on this road to Rio.

Next up for the U.S. Olympic men's basketball team is the trip to Brazil, where the Americans think they can play even better now that they're done having to go place to place.

"As a team, I think you're going to see a much different team over

there," Carmelo Anthony said.

Anthony scored 19 points and the U.S. wrapped up its unbeaten exhibition tour with a 110-66 victory over Nigeria on Monday night.

The Americans weren't quite as potent this time but were dominant defensively after pouring on the points in a record-setting romp over the Nigerians four years ago.

They forced the African champions to miss their first 22 3-point shots and held them to 4 for 29 behind the arc.

Klay Thompson had 17 points and Kevin Durant added 14 for the U.S., which went 5-0 and wasn't tested during its easy five-city, pre-Olympic schedule. The U.S. men and women — who arrived in Houston earlier Monday and attended the game — are scheduled to fly Tuesday night to Rio de Janeiro, where both will be favored to repeat as Olympic basketball champions.

"We leave tomorrow night and then it's off, hopefully, to a gold medal," U.S. coach Mike Krzyzewski said.

The men's team will have to wait until it gets there for a close game — if one comes at all. The Americans previously defeated Argentina China twice and Venezuela by ar

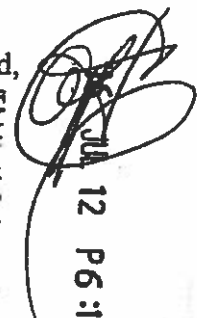
