An Act providing for the Virgin Islands Department of Public Works to replace public parking signs that refer to “handicap parking”

PROPOSED BY: Senator Janette Millin Young

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. The Virgin Islands Department of Public Works shall remove all public parking signs that refer to “handicap parking” and replace them with signs that refer to “persons with disabilities.”

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding title 33 Virgin Islands Code, section 3003a, subsection (e), the sum of \$10,000 is allotted to the Department of Public Works in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017 from the Transportation Trust Fund for the replacement of the signs.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Public Works to replace all public parking signs that refer to “handicap parking” and replace them with signs that refer to “persons with disabilities” and provides for the allotment of \$10,000 from the Transportation Trust Fund for the project.
