Dear Mr. Nelson Petty:

According to a territory wide survey conducted by my office, it has been found that more traffic lights are not working than those that are working. We are headed into the sixth month after hurricanes Irma and Maria and too many of the lights are still inactive or completely down. The absence and lack of traffic signals poses a potential for serious or even fatal accidents.

The restoration of traffic lights in the territory should be a priority of the Department of Public Works. The Virgin Islands community should at least be provided with an update on the restoration of traffic lights. I am urging you to make the broken traffic lights a priority and take action within the department to ensure all lights are restored in a more timely manner.
