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Subject: SAVE Department of Justice - VOTE NO to CLAUDE WALKER

SAVE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, PLEASE VOTE NO! TO Claude Walker! No names here for protection due to Walker's threats of termination and "criminal prosecution" of his staff to silence them, so here are the FACTS which you can verify as truth:

Walker's recent paternity and child support press conference was a mere distraction from the mess he causing and he is grand standing to make it appear he was starting something or doing something productive for the department, when the fact is those methods of collection have been in place and have been applied by the Paternity and Support Division for years since federal the laws are on the books. It is nothing new. They are audited periodically by the feds. Check those numbers...check those facts.

As Acting AG, James Carroll brought order and integrity back in the department after the chaos that the former acting AG Terri Griffiths left -- but the same disruption, intimidation, politics is back again.....

Confusion and disruption-Walker making random and senseless shifts and transfers of attorneys and administrative staff to sections (between civil, paternity,criminal) some with only a days notice and without any regard or planning for a smooth transition of cases or tasks to the detriment of the productivity and efficiency of the department. The cases suffer - they have to drop everything and go then the remaining staff left to figure it out. Continuing where Griffiths left off—it starts again.

Intimidation, threats, fear - Walker through his Deputy Carty, sent the infamous threatening memo to the staff to silence and intimidate staff members from disclosing information about what is going on in the department, without describing what kind of information is "confidential" or and even threatening them with termination and criminal prosecution without saying what crime (assuming there is one). Walker kept it vague enough to keep the staff afraid to say anything at all. Please ask Walker to identify the criminal offense they will prosecute under? Doubt there is any, just an empty threat something he trumped up to scare and intimidate potential whistle blowers.

At the heels of that threatening memo Walker started terminating employees 5 total almost weekly, and making announcements to staff for about a four week period--- terminations for no apparent reason. Staff on pins and needles who would be the next "termination of the week".

Promoting public corruption, fraud, disregard for the law to prosecute public corruption—Attorney General is supposed to be fighting against corruption yet Walker's first major move within weeks of becoming acting AG was to dismantle the already understaffed White Collar Public Corruption Crime Division that his predecessor, former Acting Attorney General/Judge James Carroll, was making efforts to rebuild and strengthen when Governor Mapp abruptly removed and replaced him with Walker. Walker abruptly transferred the only experienced white

collar prosecutor to the criminal division to handle “regular crimes” and re assigned the white collar cases to other attorneys in the criminal division to prosecute, who are less experienced. **WALKER IS VIOLATING THE LAW** that requires the department to have a **White Collar and Public Corruption Section** to "**institute aggressive prosecution of white collar crime and corruption**", meaning *all* corruption by public officials not just the Governor's political adversaries. **See Title 3 VIC 118** now please. Walker then revised the DOJ website to make it look to the public that there is a functioning white collar public corruption division staffed with Assistant AGs so it could look like he complying with the law. That is fraud and corruption! If he says he has a division, ask him what AGs in it and how many cases prosecuting.

Many at DOJ suffering in silence, Walker gave some long overdue raises to assure their loyalty, but we cannot afford to be silent. And we cannot afford for you our representatives to be slack on your duty to act in the public interest. You are the only ones who can stop this!
